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EDITORIAL STATEMENT/COMMUNIQUÉ DE LA RÉDACTION

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LA REVUE *PHOENIX* publie des articles scientifiques aux conclusions originales dans tous les domaines des études classiques: littérature, histoire, philosophie, religions, mythologie, sciences, archéologie, arts, architecture et culture du monde gréco-romain. Les limites chronologiques sont extrêmement larges, des origines à l'Antiquité tardive (ca 600 de notre ère). *Phoenix* ne publie que les articles qui contribuent de façon originale et significative à notre compréhension de l'antiquité gréco-romaine. Les argumentations qui reposent sur de nouvelles méthodologies et de nouvelles approches sont les bienvenus. Le comité de rédaction sollicite des articles sur des thèmes plus généraux qu'auparavant, aussi bien que ceux qui traitent d'un seul problème d'une façon plus détaillée. L'auteur doit s'assurer de la clarté de sa démonstration et en souligner l'importance. Enfin les articles peuvent être accompagnés de photographies en noir et blanc, de cartes et de dessins au trait. Prière de noter que *Phoenix* ne retient généralement pas les propositions d'articles dont le manuscrit fait plus de 50 pages.
